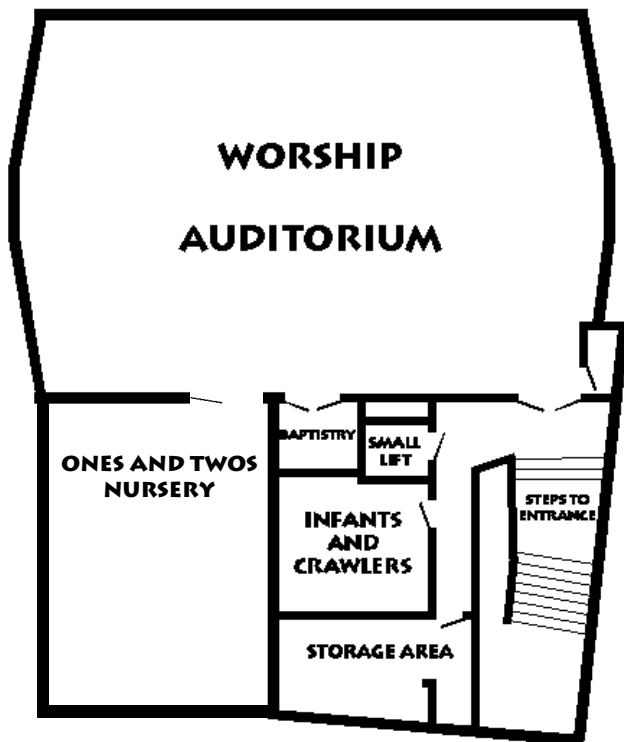


## FLOORPLAN @ FEG (MOZARTSTR. 12)

## MICC SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS SCHEDULE

**4:00** Nurseries open for infants, ones and twos  
Preschool class begins (ages 3-6)  
(Ground floor HH25, across street)  
(Gr. 1-Youth are in adult worship until 4:30)

**4:30** Sunday School classes begin for Grades 1 through Youth

**5:30** Sunday School dismissed  
Please pick up preschoolers from classroom  
Children in grades 1-6 will be escorted back from across the street

### CLASS DIVISIONS<sup>†</sup>

<sup>†</sup>Any exceptions should be discussed and cleared with the teachers involved, the director and the Sunday School elder.

**ONES/TWOS** child joins class after he begins to walk steadily and remains until promotion day\* *after 3rd birthday*

**PRESCHOOL (AGES 3-6)** child joins class on promotion day\* *after 3rd birthday* and remains until promotion day\* *as he begins 1st Grade.*

**GRADE 1-6** classes are divided into 2 year groupings (Grades 1-2; 3-4; 5-6). Child joins class in September of the year he begins the lower grade (and remains through the summer (until Sept.) of the year he begins the next grouping.

**YOUTH** young person joins class in September of the year he begins 7th grade and continues through graduation.

\*Promotion for preschoolers can take place in September, December, March, or June. Promotion day is in early September.

## WELCOME!

In MICC, we want to make our Sunday school a very special place where Christ is glorified, parents are equipped, and children are trained in righteousness. *Your children matter to God, and they matter to us.*

We desire to have both men and women teachers in every age group for proper role modeling as we seek to reach the whole child (intellect, emotions and will) through Bible study, prayer, fellowship and play. We also seek to have three teachers who rotate so that teachers can attend worship services.

In the international environment, it is important for parents to know that their children are being cared for, so we seek to provide a warm, accepting, safe environment where children can relax and be loved, enabling them to drink in the truth of God's Word, grow, and see their lives changed by it.

## SUNDAY SCHOOL AND THE CHILD

We are committed to teaching God's word and modeling a Christian way of life before the children so that each child is fully engaged in the learning process. This involves using a variety of tasks and methods to effectively reach a child's whole personality:

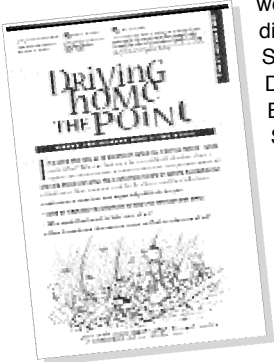
-his mind (knowledge)	to <b>know</b> the truth
-his emotions (feelings)	to <b>love</b> the truth
-his will (response)	to <b>do</b> the truth

We are also committed to building relationships with the children, believing that learning increases in the context of loving personal relationships. It is our hope that we excite our children so much about Sunday School and what they learn—that they're talking about the lesson all week and can't wait to return the next Sunday!!

## SUNDAY SCHOOL AND THE HOME

God has ordained the home as the nurture center for children, so we desire to work with parents to be more effective in their roles. Our Sunday school is not meant to replace parental instruction, but to support, encourage and equip parents to fulfill their God given task of raising children in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Each Sunday, your child will receive a copy of "Driving Home the Point" which will have questions for you to ask later in the day or in the week. This old standby conversation won't have to happen again—Dad: "What did you learn in Sunday school?" Son: "Lots of different things." Dad: "Well, tell me then—what was your Bible story about today?" Son: "David... or was it Moses?" In the flyer, you will be given suggestions for questions, a statement of the Bible story, a key verse (good for Bible memory) and several suggestions for family devotions, family activities and continuing applications of God's word to your life throughout the week.



***New teachers and helpers are always welcome and needed in all classes and nurseries. Let's all do our share!***

## OUR CURRICULUM

We have selected the *FaithWeaver*® curriculum to provide a foundation for Biblical teaching in the classroom. One of the strengths of these materials is their consistency across age groupings. During each Sunday, all children age 3 through 6th grade will study the same Bible truth and story at their own level. This will help families to be able to discuss, reinforce and apply the biblical truth throughout the week.

Using a variety of methods the children will be exposed to God's word through all their senses—seeing, hearing, feeling, touching, speaking and even tasting. Various learning styles are explored to make sure that each child is given full opportunity to learn to his maximum potential. The Bible theme is woven through activities, role plays, music, study, drama, scripture memory games, and crafts. The objective is that the child "experience the truth" of the day's lesson and apply it to his personal life.

## LOVE AND DISCIPLINE

Learning does not occur when there is chaos, so in each class we will establish behavior guidelines and work with parents to communicate when problems arise. Because we love the children, and we honor God's word, we desire to train them in good behavior in listening, contributing and cooperating in their class.

We use a discipline "contract" for older classes. If you would like to see a copy, please contact Robin Henderson. We encourage teachers to discuss behavior problems first with the child, then with parents. Please help by reinforcing respect and good behavior if you are approached by your child's teacher.

If your child is given a note requesting that he sit in church with you the next Sunday, please honor this request and please train him appropriately at home to help him understand the importance of good behavior in the Sunday School classroom.

## WHAT IF THERE IS A PROBLEM?

If your child is ill or upset or a continual distraction in the class, the teacher will send an SMS to our pastor, and he will discreetly ask you to go attend to your child.

## INSTRUCTION IN ENGLISH

Because we are an international, English speaking church, our classes will be in English. Some children in our church are not native English speakers, and this creates a challenge for us, since not all of our teachers are fluent in German. We will seek to be flexible with our instruction, and ask for your flexibility and patience as well as we care for your child.

## OUR TEACHERS

Please get to know the names of your child's teachers. Please encourage your child's teacher by saying thanks, by praying for them and by caring for them. Teaching is a strategic and powerful ministry in the lives of our children, our families and our church.
